- **Preamble:** A Two day workshop on **“Employment and Career Guidance”** has been conducted on 25th and 26th February 2019 at Vidya Vikas Mandal’s Sitaram Govind Patil Arts, Science and Commerce College, Sakri jointly organized with Department of Student Development, Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon in order to know the scenario of employment market and guidance regarding career to fit the current market.
- **Participant’s Profile:** A total of 57 delegates from 05 colleges of the surrounding area including Host College participated. Among the participants, 30 students were

from other colleges and 07 students were from the host college. 18 teachers of S.G.Patil College and 02 teachers from other colleges actively participated in the workshop.

25th February 2019 (Monday)

➤ **Inauguration of the Workshop:**

On the inaugural function, Hon. Prin. Dr.D.L.Torawane (Administrative Officer, Vidya Vikas Mandal, Sakri) inaugurated the workshop by enlightening the lamp and offering garland to the image of Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari. Prin.Dr.R.R.Ahire, Prof. Anant B. Patil (Vice-Principal), Dr Sanjay S. Sonawane (Senate Member, Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon) Prof. Indrajit S. Sonawane (Head, Placement Cell, Sandip University, Nashik, M.S.), Mr Harshal Desale (Co-Founder N-Tech Solutions IT Firm, Nashik, M.S.) Prof. Sunil D. - **Session-I:** First session has been conducted by Prof Indrajit S. Sonawane on '**How to be competent for the Job**'. The session was chaired by Dr V B Bachchhao (Head, Department of English) Prof. Dnyaneshwar Chavan anchored the session. In his session, Prof. Indrajit Sonawane elaborated five key elements that are really important for being competent for any job in the market. He has explained these elements with relevant examples. - **Session-II:** Mr Harshal Desale conducted the second session on '**Interview Techniques and Employment Opportunities**'. Dr M. M. Saindane (Head, Department of Geography) chaired the session. He has discussed the basics of the interview and its whole process. Later he focused on how some useful techniques enhance our ability to face interview. Successful interview leads to the employability hence students should prepare themselves in such a way that they should grab the opportunity. - **Session-III:** Mr Shreejith R. Nair, Corporate Trainer, dealt with various aspects of personality development. He had called some of the participants to participate in various activities that lead them to understand the concepts of personality development. It was an interactive session. Mr Nair focused on various aspects of a

given topic. The third session was chaired by Dr Prakash Salunke (Head, Department of Marathi). He has stated the key points presented by the resource person.

- **Session IV:** This session was conducted by Mr K. S. Bachchhao. In this session, Mr Bachchhao conducted a quiz on Science and technology. Mr Suhas Sonawane, the active member of Marathi Vidnyan Parishad, Sakri helped in this session. Both have formed five groups of participated students. The quiz was conducted through three rounds. The instructions regarding the quiz were given to the participants. Students in the groups enthusiastically participated in the quiz. First prize is won by the Group A and second prize is grabbed by Group B. First prize was of Rs.500/- and second, was of Rs.200/-. Marathi Vidnyan Parishad, Sakri chapter sponsored these prizes.
