Shanivari Vidnyanvari (Science on Saturday)

This is flagship programme of 'Marathi Vidnyan Parishad' designed especially for learning science through low cost hands on experiments. Another important feature of this programme is peer learning and capacity building of college students as science communicators.

Mr. Hemant Lagvankar has conceptualized this programme and he is working as the Principal Investigator of the programme while Dr. Jayant Joshi, Hon. Secretary, Marathi Vidnyan Parishad is the Chief co-ordinator.

The programme was started in about 12 schools in Nasik on the pilot basis in the year 2016-17. The trained college students were divided in groups of two and each group was assigned one school. Each group of college students conducted 10 sessions of about 2 hours each on every Saturday in the school assigned to them. Since the program is being conducted on Saturdays, it is named as '*Shanivari Vidnyanvari*'. During these sessions concepts in science are explained through hands on experiments. Students in school learned these concepts by actually carrying out the experiments.

In 2019-20, our college collaborated with Marathi Vidnyan Parishad for the project Shanivari Vidnyanvari under which 20 students from F.Y.B.Sc. and S.Y.B.Sc. volunteered (vidnyan mitra) for the two-day training workshop at Jalgaon where students were given training and experiment kits. Shri. Sucheta Bhide, Shri. Anagha Vakte, Shri. Shubhada Vakte, Shri. Hemant Lagvankar were involved in training college students. Students then visited Marathi or semi-English medium schools of their choice from sakri tahsil, on Saturdays, to teach science to class VI and VII students through interesting experiments. Prof. Dinesh Khairnar, Department of chemistry of our college worked as College Coordinator for the project Shanivari Vidnyanvari under the guidance of our Principal Dr. R. R Ahire who is officiating Incharge and Dr. D. L. Torawane who is President of Marathi Vidnyan Parishad, Sakri region.

During September 2019 to January 2020 these 20 students successfully completed the project in 10 schools and about 372 school children's are benefited from it in 100 sessions. These 20 students are financially assisted by Marathi Vidnyan Parishad after completion of project. The participation of students in this activity proved that our college takes effort to make them life-long learners and innovators.
